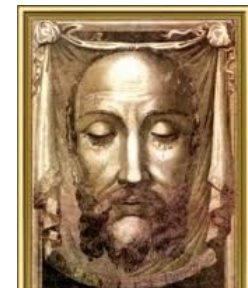

## **Dedicated Staff**

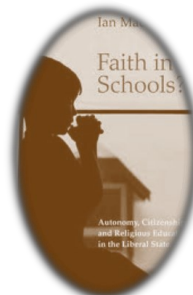
